Trail Riders CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Ride only on designated trails
 2. Stay on the trail, avoid short cuts or forming new trails
 3. Comply with signage
 4. Respect the rights of other trail users
 5. Politely indicate to other trail users how to pass
 6. Remove rubbish, manure from horse float parking area
 7. Let others know of this code
- ✓ Check fire ban warnings. This trail is in the Adelaide Hills Fire Ban District
 - ✓ Horse riders will need a permit to ride on ForestrySA land
 - ✓ On Total Fire Ban days entry into the forest is prohibited
 - ✓ Horse float parking is available at the end of Forest Road, Kersbrook
 - ✓ Practice phytophthora hygiene
 - ✓ Report trail repairs to the land manager

General Considerations

Keep trails open by setting a good example of environmentally sound and socially responsible trail use. Leave gates as you found them. It is recommended to wear approved safety helmets and hi-viz clothing.

Users of the trail do so at their own risk. Horse riding, cycling and walking involve risks and should be undertaken with care and regard for other trail and road users and the environment at all times. The trail is subject to natural forces, varying weather and track conditions.

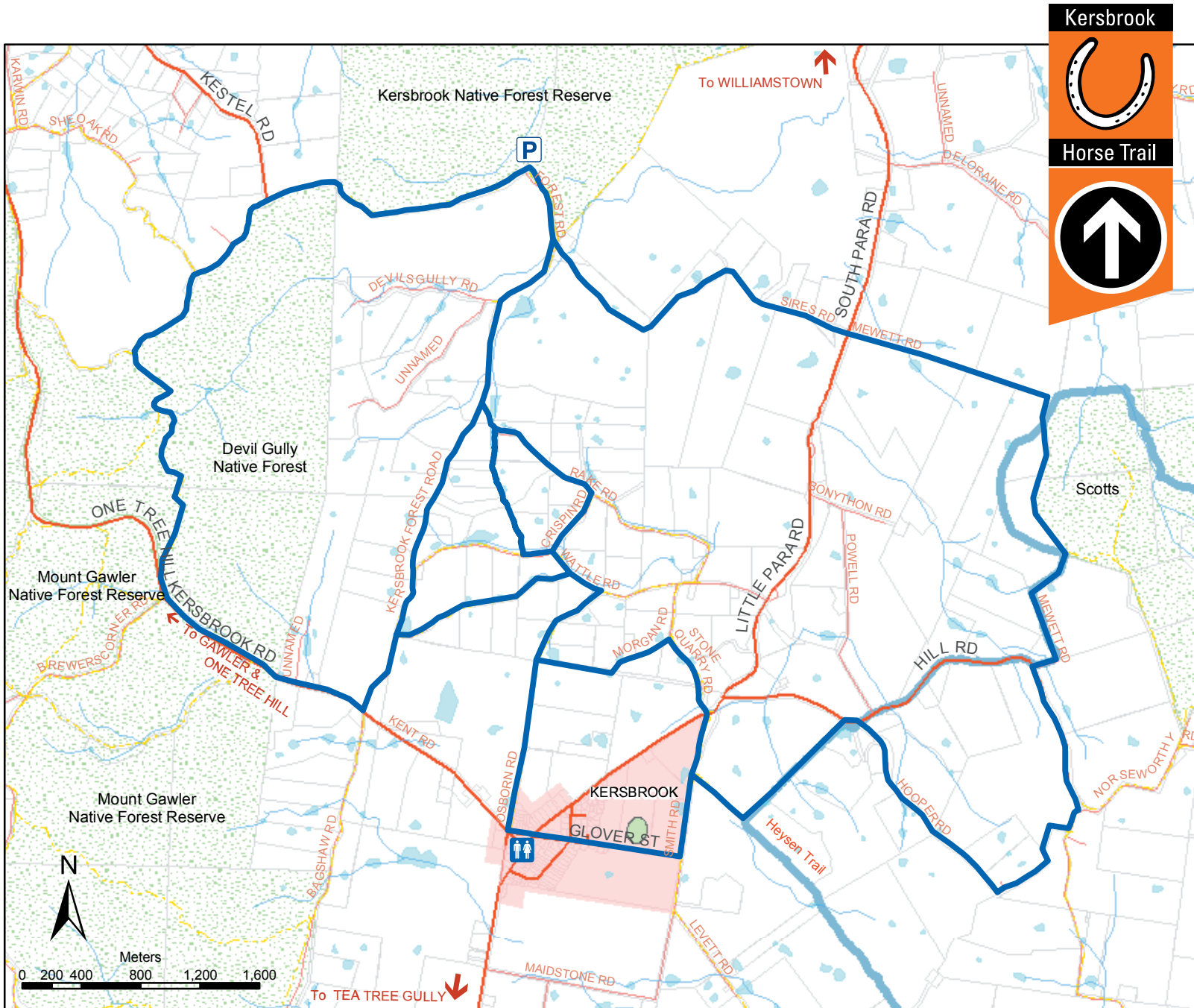
